My *Antonia* (first published 1918) is considered the greatest novel by American writer Willa Cather. My *Antonia* — pronounced with the accent on the first syllable of "*Antonia*" — is the final book of the "prairie trilogy" of novels by Cather, a list that also includes *O Pioneers!* and *The Song of the Lark*. My *Antonia* tells the stories of several immigrant families who move out to rural Nebraska to start new lives in America, with a particular focus on a Bohemian family, the Shimerdas, whose eldest daughter is named *Antonia*.
