June 1st, 2020 - one contribution point currently equals 282 58 euro pay in employee side only vs 30 45 euro pay out assuming an average growth rate of 2 5 as currently announced till 2029 and a timeframe between pay in and pay out of 30 years you only need to live 4 4 times as long during pay out time as you spent contributing
